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HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 206

STUDENT/TUITION: Creates a task force to study issues relative to tuition costs at public postsecondary education institutions

A RESOLUTION

2	To create a task force to study issues relative to tuition costs at public postsecondary
3	education institutions and to submit a written report of task force findings and
4	recommendations to the House Committee on Education not later than sixty days
5	prior to the beginning of the 2014 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
6	WHEREAS, Louisiana's public postsecondary education system has faced severe
7	budget cuts in the last several years; and
8	WHEREAS, to compensate for this loss of state funding, public postsecondary
9	education institutions have had to increase tuition and decrease spending, often in ways that
10	compromise the quality of the education they offer; and
11	WHEREAS, these cuts have significantly reduced college access and affordability
12	and have shifted costs from the state to students and families; and
13	WHEREAS, declining state funding and the rising cost of tuition have serious
14	consequences for students, their families, and the state's economy as well; and
15	WHEREAS, research has shown that rapidly rising tuition results in declining
16	enrollment; and
17	WHEREAS, increasing tuition costs also drive up the cost of the Taylor Opportunity
18	Program for Students (TOPS); and
19	WHEREAS, TOPS was created by the legislature in 1997 as a way to improve access
20	to postsecondary education institutions for high school graduates; and

1	WHEREAS, additionally, the Granting Autonomies and Resources for Diplomas Act,
2	enacted by the legislature in 2010, was created to address the many challenges facing public
3	postsecondary education in Louisiana, including those dealing with tuition; and
4	WHEREAS, many students who graduate from high school do not know what
5	opportunities are available to them and how to successfully access and navigate the
6	postsecondary education system in order to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to be
7	successful in life regardless of what path they choose to pursue; and
8	WHEREAS, promoting college access and affordability is an urgent priority for
9	Louisiana if the state is to develop productive citizens who successfully compete in today's
10	global economy; and
11	WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that a comprehensive study be conducted
12	to review and examine the rising cost of tuition and other related issues in order to maximize
13	higher education opportunities for all students.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
15	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby create a task force to study issues relative to tuition
16	costs at public postsecondary education institutions and to submit a written report of task
17	force findings and recommendations, including any recommendations for legislation, to the
18	House Committee on Education not later than sixty days prior to the beginning of the 2014
19	Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall be composed of the
21	following members:
22	(1) The commissioner of higher education, or his designee.
23	(2) The chairman of the Board of Regents, or his designee.
24	(3) The chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and
25	Agricultural and Mechanical College, or his designee.
26	(4) The chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Southern University and
27	Agricultural and Mechanical College, or his designee.
28	(5) The chairman of the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana
29	System, or his designee.

1	(6) The chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical
2	Colleges, or his designee.
3	(7) A faculty representative from a public postsecondary four-year institution, to be
4	appointed by the commissioner of higher education.
5	(8) A faculty representative from a public postsecondary two-year institution, to be
6	appointed by the commissioner of higher education.
7	(9) The chairman of the Louisiana Student Financial Assistance Commission, or his
8	designee.
9	(10) Five students representing public postsecondary education institutions to be
10	appointed by the commissioner of higher education.
11	(11) Two members representing business and industry to be appointed by the
12	governor.
13	(12) The state superintendent of education, or his designee.
14	(13) The president of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, or
15	his designee.
16	(14) Five public high school students to be appointed by the state superintendent of
17	education.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study shall include but not be limited to a
19	review and examination of the following issues:
20	(1) The rising cost of tuition at public postsecondary education institutions.
21	(2) The impact of such rising tuition costs on TOPS and any possible changes to the
22	program that may be needed as a result.
23	(3) The impact of such rising tuition costs on the Granting Resources and
24	Autonomies for Diplomas Act and any possible changes to the Act that may be needed as
25	a result.
26	(4) The impact of such rising costs on the quality of the education programs offered
27	to students by public postsecondary education institutions.
28	(5) The cost savings, including those to TOPS, that may result if more students
29	enroll in community and technical colleges and then transfer to four-year institutions.

1 (6) Any additional strategies or incentives for increasing college access and 2 affordability.

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- (7) Any new methods for imposing tuition that could provide additional revenue for public postsecondary education.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commissioner of higher education or his designee shall be responsible for convening the task force and for designating staff to assist the task force in conducting its study.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the task force shall serve without compensation.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the commissioner of higher education, the chairmen of the Board of Regents, the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, the Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System, the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance Commission, the state superintendent of education, the president of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, and the governor.
