PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Provides relative to the transfer of a certain parcel of land from La. Tech University to the city of Ruston

Report adopts Senate amendments to:

1. Add authorization to transfer certain state property in Vernon Parish, Ouachita Parish, and Richland Parish from the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to the Dept. of Transportation and Development.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

Authorizes the transfer or lease of certain state property in Lincoln Parish <u>from</u> La. Tech University <u>to</u> the city of Ruston. Provides for the reservation of mineral rights to the state.

Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Vernon Parish, Ouachita Parish, and Richland Parish from the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to the Dept. of Transportation and Development.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
