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CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

House Bill No. 452 by Representative Fannin

FUNDS/FUNDING: Provides for the transfer of deposits and monies among state funds

Report adopts Senate amendments to:

- 1. Delete the transfer out of the Video Draw Poker Device Purse Supplement Fund, Bossier Parish Truancy Fund, and Calcasieu Parish Fund into the Overcollections Fund.
- 2. Decrease the estimate of revenue from Fees and Self-generated revenues from the Dept of Revenue by \$16 million.
- 3. Add transfers out of the Community Water Enrichment Fund, the Louisiana Fire Marshal Fund, the 2% Fire Insurance Fund, and monies related to the assignment, transfer, sale, or lease of properties to the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to the Overcollections Fund.
- 4. Transfer out of the Overcollections Fund to Prepaid Wireless 911 Service Fees and Self-Generated Revenues from prior year collections.
- 5. Add transfer of \$1,101,881 from the Underwater Obstruction Removal Fund to the Oil and Gas Regulatory Fund.
- 6. Add transfer of \$208,800,000 from certain funds into the state general fund.
- 7. Create the Payments Toward the UAL Fund. Repeals the Incentive Fund provides that certain monies previously deposited into the Incentive Fund be included in the deposits into the new fund.
- 8. Added provisions of law regarding the executive director of the Louisiana Housing Corporation.
- 9. Add provisions changing the allocation of funds in the Shreveport Riverfront and Convention Center and Independence Stadium Fund.

- 10. Add provisions relative to the uses of the Louisiana State Parks Improvement and Repair Fund.
- 11. Repeal the Budget Stabilization Replenishment Fund and created the FMAP Stabilization Fund.

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

1. Deleted transfer of \$200 million from certain funds into the state general fund.

Report amends the bill to:

- 1. Changes provisions related to the Payments Towards the UAL Fund.
- 2. Make provisions restricting deposits into the Budget Stabilization Fund under certain circumstances null, void, and of no effect on July 1, 2015.
- 2. Provides for changes, additions, and deletions of transfers out of the various funds into the Overcollections Fund and into the state general fund.
- 3. Provides that the Act shall become effective only if House Bill No. 437 is enacted into law.
