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Provides relative to school crisis management and response plans and school resource officers

The proposed legislation requires each public school principal to review the school's crisis management and response plan at least once annually and revise it as necessary. The principal to include input from students enrolled in the school and their parents, teachers at the school, other school employees, community leaders, and local law enforcement, fire, public safety, and emergency preparedness officials. Each public school is required to conduct a safety drill at least twice per year to rehearse the safety plan. Each school resource officer may be armed with a firearm authorized by a law enforcement agency at all times while on duty as a school resource officer.
