

Burrell (HB 92)

Act No. 377

Existing law defines "authorized positions" as the number of positions approved by the legislature in an appropriation bill to be funded by the "salaries continuing category" of the accounting system for the state. Further authorizes the number to be adjusted during a fiscal year in accordance with law.

New law adds a new definition of "authorized other charges positions" as the number of positions in an appropriation bill to be funded by the other charges continuing category of the accounting system for the state. Provides that such number may be adjusted in the fiscal year in accordance with law.

Existing law requires that the executive budget and supporting document contain certain information, including personnel tables for each department.

New law requires that personnel tables include information pertaining to authorized other charges positions.

Effective August 1, 2013.
