

Existing law provides that the governing authority of an airport district composed of land situated in only one parish may either be the governing body of the parish in which the district is located or a board of commissioners created by the governing body of the parish that created the airport district.

Prior law specified that if a board of commissioners is created, the board shall be composed of either five or seven members, so designated at the option of the governing body of the parish and shall be selected by the governing body of the parish.

New law retains prior law and adds the authority for the governing body of the parish to create a board of commissioners composed of nine members.

Effective August 1, 2013.
