Jones (HB 128)

<u>Existing law</u> provides for payment of \$250,000 to the surviving spouse, child, or other beneficiary of a fireman or law enforcement officer who suffers death as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties or arising out of any activity in his capacity as a fireman or officer in the protection of life and property. Specifies the firemen and law enforcement officers to whom <u>existing law</u> is applicable.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>existing law</u> is applicable to paid or volunteer firemen of any federally or state-recognized Indian tribe or tribal unit and to full-time tribal law enforcement officers employed by a federally or state-recognized Indian tribe or tribal unit.

Effective August 1, 2013.
