Price (HB 349) Act No. 152

With regard to the crime of simple escape, <u>prior law</u> provided that if a person who is participating in a work release program commits the crime of simple escape, the court shall sentence the person to imprisonment for not less than six months nor more than one year. <u>Prior law</u> further prohibited that sentence from running concurrently to any other sentence imposed.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> by providing the court with discretion as to whether to impose a sentence of imprisonment and by removing the provision which prohibits any sentence imposed for the simple escape from a work release program from running concurrently to any other sentence imposed.

Effective August 1, 2013.
