SENATE BILL NO. 10

BY SENATOR MORRISH

PROPERTY INSURANCE. Prohibits the recovery of penalties in class action suits against La. Citizens Property Insurance Corporation. (8/1/14)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 22:2296.1, relative to recovery against Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation; to prohibit claimants from recovering penalties from Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation in the form of class action lawsuits; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:2296.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§2296.1. Recovery of penalties; class action

Any action to recover a penalty or minimum measure of recovery against the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation that is created or imposed by statute shall not be maintained as a class action.
