1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:4024, relative to the Student Scholarships for Educational
3	Excellence Program; to require the Department of Education to report annually
4	certain information regarding the program to state legislators; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:4024 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§4024. Reports
9	A. The department annually shall report to the Senate Committee on
10	Education, the House Committee on Education, and the Joint Legislative Committee
11	on the Budget regarding the implementation of the program, including the number
12	of eligible students receiving scholarships, a list of participating schools and the
13	number of scholarship recipients each such school enrolled, and aggregate test result
14	data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in each participating school.
15	B. The department annually shall report to each state senator and state
16	representative regarding the schools in his respective district participating in
17	the program. Such report shall include a list of all participating schools located

б	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
7	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
8	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
9	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
10	effective on the day following such approval.

Brown (SB 31)

<u>Present law</u> requires the Department of Education (DOE) to report annually to the Senate Committee on Education, the House Committee on Education, and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget regarding the implementation of the program, including the number of eligible students receiving scholarships, a list of participating schools and the number of scholarship recipients each such school enrolled, and aggregate test result data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in each participating school.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally requires DOE to report annually to each state senator and state representative regarding the schools in his respective district participating in the program. Further provides that such report shall include a list of all participating schools located in the legislator's district, the total number of students receiving scholarships enrolled in each participating school, aggregate test result data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in each participating school, and historical scholarship recipient and aggregate test result data for every year the school has participated in the program.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
