Thompson HB No. 145

**Abstract:** Exempts from seizure all firearms and firearm accessories owned by a debtor.

<u>Present law</u> provides general exemptions from seizure under any writ, mandate, or process for specified income or property of a debtor.

<u>Present law</u> includes the debtor's arms and military accourrements in the list of properties exempt from seizure.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that all of the debtor's firearms and accessories to those firearms are exempt from seizure.

Present law provides an exemption from seizure of one firearm with a maximum value of \$500.

Proposed law repeals present law.
