TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE: Dedicates a portion of the state excise tax levied on beverages of low alcoholic content to the La. Wounded Warriors Fund

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 26:342 and to enact Subpart S of Chapter 1 of Part II-A of 3 Subtitle I of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of 4 R.S. 39:100.137, relative to state taxes on beverages of low alcoholic content; to 5 dedicate a portion of the state taxes on beverages of low alcoholic content; to establish the Louisiana Wounded Warriors Fund in the state treasury; to provide for 6 7 the deposit, use, and investment of the monies in the fund; to provide for an effective 8 date; and to provide for related matters. 9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 10 Section 1. R.S. 26:342 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 11 §342. Tax on beverages of low alcoholic content 12 There is levied and imposed on all beverages of low alcoholic content 13 handled in Louisiana an excise tax of ten dollars per barrel containing not more than thirty-one gallons, and at a like rate for fractional parts of a barrel. Fifteen percent 14 15 of the avails of the tax levied pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall be 16 deposited into the Louisiana Wounded Warrior Fund as provided for in R.S. 17 39:100.137. 18 Section 2. Subpart S of Chapter 1 of Part II-A of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the 19 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 39:100.137, is hereby enacted to read 20 as follows:

1	SUBPART S. LOUISIANA WOUNDED WARRIOR FUND
2	§100.137. Louisiana Wounded Warrior Fund
3	A. There is hereby established in the state treasury, as a special fund, the
4	Louisiana Wounded Warrior Fund, hereinafter referred to as the "fund".
5	B. After satisfying the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the
6	Constitution of Louisiana relative to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, the
7	state treasurer shall annually deposit into the fund an amount equal to fifteen percent
8	of the avails of the state excise tax levied pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 26:342
9	All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year
10	shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the state
11	treasurer in the same manner as monies in the state general fund, and interest earned
12	on the investment of monies shall be credited to the state general fund.
13	C. The monies in the fund shall be appropriated and used solely for expenses
14	and costs associated with the rehabilitation of Louisiana veterans wounded while
15	serving overseas in the United States military during the Persian Gulf War as
16	prescribed by the presidential proclamation or concurrent resolution of congress
17	The monies in the fund shall also be appropriated and used solely for expenses and
18	costs associated with the rehabilitation of Louisiana veterans wounded while serving
19	in the United States military during any wartime periods in which the United States
20	of America was engaged in war activities since the end of the Persian Gulf War.
21	Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014; if vetoed by the governor
22	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
23	2014, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Abstract: Dedicates 15% of the state excise tax levied on beverages of low alcoholic content to the La. Wounded Warrior Fund.

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<u>Present law</u> provides for the levy and imposition of an excise tax on all beverages of low alcoholic content of \$10 per barrel containing not more than 31 gallons, and at a like rate for fractional parts of a barrel.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but requires that 15% of the avails of the tax levied pursuant to <u>present law</u> be deposited into the La. Wounded Warrior Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the La. Wounded Warrior Fund as a special fund in the state treasury. Further requires, after satisfying the requirements of the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, the state treasurer to annually deposit into the fund 15% of the avails of the state excise tax levied pursuant to <u>present law</u> on beverages of low alcoholic content.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies appropriated from the fund to be used solely for expenses and costs associated with the rehabilitation of La. veterans wounded while serving overseas in the U.S. military during the Persian Gulf War or for expenses and costs associated with the rehabilitation of La. veterans wounded during any wartime periods in which the U.S. was engaged in war activities since the end of the Persian Gulf War.

Effective July 1, 2014.
