Abstract: Provides for applicability of regulations relative to water supplies.

Proposed law establishes that no provision of present law or present La. Administrative Code relative to water supplies, water systems, water service connections, groundwater, water wells, or potable water in general shall be construed to require any of the following:

- (1) Installation of any of the following at a residential property which comprises no more than two dwelling units:
 - (a) A backflow preventer.
 - (b) More than one water meter.
- (2) Connection to a public water system of any residential property that may draw potable water from a private well in a manner allowed by law.
