Abstract: Provides for applicability of regulations relative to water supplies.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes that no provision of <u>present law</u> or <u>present La. Administrative Code</u> relative to water supplies, water systems, water service connections, groundwater, water wells, or potable water in general shall be construed to require any of the following:

- (1) Installation of any of the following at a residential property which comprises no more than two dwelling units:
 - (a) A backflow preventer.
 - (b) More than one water meter.
- (2) Connection to a public water system of any residential property that may draw potable water from a private well in a manner allowed by law.
