CORRECTIONS: Adds "correctional facility employee" to the list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 14:30(A)(12) and (B)(4), relative to first degree murder; to add "correctional
3	facility employee" to the list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder;
4	to provide for a definition of "correctional facility employee"; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:30(A)(12) and (B)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§30. First degree murder
9	A. First degree murder is the killing of a human being:
10	* * *
11	(12) When the offender has a specific intent to kill or to inflict great bodily
12	harm upon a correctional facility employee who is in the course and scope of his
13	employment.

16	(4) For purposes of Paragraph (A)(12) of this Section, the term "correctional
17	facility employee" means any employee of any jail, prison, or correctional facility
18	that is not a peace officer as defined by the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this
19	Subsection.

Havard HB No. 278

Abstract: Adds "correctional facility employee" to the list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder.

<u>Present law</u> defines first degree murder as the killing of a human being when certain circumstances exist or when the specific intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm is directly related to the victim's status.

<u>Present law</u> provides that persons convicted of first degree murder shall be punished by death or life imprisonment at hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds "correctional facility employee" to the <u>present law</u> list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "correctional facility employee" as any employee of any jail, prison, or correctional facility that is not a "peace officer" as defined by <u>present law</u>.
