SENATE BILL NO. 132

GAMING. Provides relative to the certain records held by the Board of Gaming Control.
(8/1/14)

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 27:21(B)(2) and to enact R.S. 27:21(B)(3), relative to certain records held by the Board of Gaming Control; to authorize the board to adopt rules pertaining to the release of certain records; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 27:21(B)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 27:21(B)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§21. Records of board deemed open, exceptions

* * *

B.(1) * * *

(2) **In accordance with rules adopted by the board, records containing information identified in R.S. 27:21(A)(2)(c) may be released to the person who submitted the record or his designee.**

(3) Notice of the content of any information or data furnished or released pursuant to **Paragraph (1) of this Section Subsection** may be given to the applicant or licensee to whom it pertains in a manner prescribed by rules adopted by the board.

DIGEST

Morrell (SB 132)

Present law provides for confidentiality of certain records held by the Board of Gaming Control.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the board to adopt rules to provide for the release of records containing an applicant's personal history forms or questionnaires, disclosure forms, or financial statements and records to such applicant or his designee.

Proposed law authorizes the board to give notice of the content of any information or data furnished or released pursuant to present law to the applicant or licensee to whom the information pertains.

Effective August 1, 2014.
