MOTOR VEHICLES. Authorize university logo to be placed on a driver's license or identification card issued by the office of motor vehicles. (1/1/15)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 32:412(M) and R.S. 40:1321(M), relative to drivers' licenses and special
3	identification cards; to provide for the exhibition of the logo of any state university
4	on a driver's license and special identification card; to authorize collection of a
5	university logo fee, if any, as established by any state university for the use and
6	display of its logo; to provide for the disbursement of such logo fees collected to the
7	foundation of such universities; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 32:412(M) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation;
11	university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation; disbursement of funds;
12	renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D" or "E" drivers'
13	licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception

15	M.(1) Upon request and payment of a university logo fee, if any, as
16	established by any state university for the use and display of its logo, the logo
17	of any such state university shall be exhibited in color on the driver's license

20	M.(1) Upon request and payment of a university logo fee, if any, as
21	established by a state university for the use and display of its logo, the logo of
22	any such state university shall be exhibited in color on the special identification
23	card. The deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections,
24	public safety services, shall comply with the provisions of this Subsection.
25	(2) The department shall collect such university logo fee, if any, which
26	fee shall be disbursed in accordance with Paragraph (3) of this Subsection. This
27	university logo fee shall be in addition to the payment of any other special
28	identification card fee.
29	(3) Any monies received from such state university logo fee shall be

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1 disbursed quarterly by the department to the foundation of the university.

(4) The deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and

Corrections, public safety services, shall establish such rules and regulations as

are necessary to implement the provisions of this Subsection.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2015.

DIGEST

Mills (SB 138)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for exhibition of any state university's logo in color on a driver's license or identification card, upon request and payment of a university logo fee, if any, established by a state university for the use and display of its logo.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for collection of such university logo fees by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPSC) and quarterly disbursement of monies collected to the foundation of such state universities.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the DPSC to establish rules and regulations as necessary for implementation.

Effective January 1, 2015.
