1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 39:88, relative to the expenditure of state funds; to prohibit the expenditure
3	of state funds for certain assessments of students; to provide an exception; and to
4	provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 39:88 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	<u>§88. Use of state funds prohibited; assessments; exception</u>
8	No state funds may be expended for the implementation or administration of
9	any assessment proposed or developed by the Partnership for Assessment of
10	Readiness for College and Careers, the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium,
11	or any other equivalent national group or consortium unless specifically authorized
12	<u>by law.</u>
