PROCUREMENT: Provides relative to the purchase of seats with arms in public seating areas of state buildings

1 AN ACT

2 To enact Subpart L of Part III of Chapter 17 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes
3 of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 39:1647, relative to procurement; to provide for the
4 purchase of certain furniture in certain circumstances; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. Subpart L of Part III of Chapter 17 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised
8 Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 39:1647 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 SUBPART L. ACQUISITION OF SEATS IN PUBLIC SEATING AREAS
10 OF STATE BUILDINGS

11 §1647. Procurement of seats in public seating areas of state buildings; requirements
12 for seats with arms

13 When the procurement officer of a using agency covered by this Chapter
14 makes any purchase of seats for public seating areas following the renovation or
15 construction of a state building, no fewer than five percent of the total seats
16 purchased shall have arms.

Abstract: Provides that no fewer than 5% of the total seats purchased for public seating areas following the renovation or construction of a state building will have arms.

Present law establishes the Louisiana Procurement Code relative to purchasing by certain state agencies.

Proposed law provides when an agency covered by present law makes any purchase of seats for public seating areas of state buildings following the renovation or construction of a state building, no fewer than five percent of the total seats purchased shall have arms.
