## SCHOOLS/TRANSPORTATION: Prohibits school bus drivers in certain parishes from picking up or dropping off children at school while the bus is in a lane of traffic

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 17:158(J) and 3996(B)(34), relative to the loading and unloading of school
3	busses at schools in certain parishes; to provide relative to adoption of policies and
4	procedures by school governing authorities regarding such loading and unloading;
5	and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:158(J) and 3996(B)(34) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§158. School buses for transportation of students; employment of bus operators;
9	alternative means of transportation; improvement of school bus turnarounds

11	J. The governing authority of each public school in a parish that contains a
12	municipality with a population of three hundred thousand or more persons according
13	to the latest federal decennial census shall adopt policies and procedures to prohibit
14	a school bus driver from loading or unloading students at the school while the bus
15	is in a traffic lane and to require that such loading and unloading be done on the
16	shoulder of the road, in a school parking lot, or other appropriate off-road location
17	at the school as determined by the governing authority.

HB No. 600

**Abstract:** Requires certain public school governing authorities and charter schools to adopt policies and procedures prohibiting the loading and unloading of children from school busses while the bus is in a traffic lane.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:158) requires each city, parish, and other local public school board to provide a student free transportation to and from school if the student lives within the board's jurisdiction and more than one mile from the school. Further authorizes the school board to provide free transportation to students who live within one mile of the school, if the board determines that conditions warrant such free transportation. <u>Present law</u> further restricts the ability of the school board to eliminate or reduce such free transportation services. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the governing authority of each public school, including charter schools, in any parish with a municipality having a population of 300,000 or more persons to prohibit the loading or unloading of students from a school bus at a school while the bus is in a traffic lane. Further requires such governing authorities to adopt policies and procedures providing for the loading and unloading of students at a school in an appropriate off-road location.
