MTR VEHICLE/COMPULS INS: Creates a penalty for school bus drivers operating buses without insurance

| 4  | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:   |
| 5  | Section 1. R.S. 32:865.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:                               |
| 6  | §865.1. Criminal sanctions for operating school bus not covered by security                  |
| 7  | A. Any school bus driver knowingly operating a motor vehicle and any                         |
| 8  | owner of a school bus allowing it to be operated when such school bus is not covered         |
| 9  | by the security required by R.S. 32:861 shall, upon conviction, be fined not more            |
| 10 | than one thousand dollars.   |
| 11 | B. If a school bus is involved in an accident within this state, and it is not               |
| 12 | covered by the security required by R.S. 32:861, the owner thereof shall, upon               |
| 13 | conviction, be fined not more than one thousand dollars and shall have the                   |
| 14 | registration of the vehicle revoked for a period of sixty days, and a school bus driver      |
| 15 | who was operating the vehicle with the knowledge that it was not insured shall have          |
| 16 | his commercial driver's license suspended for a period of one year.                          |

**Abstract:** Provides penalties for school bus drivers for operating a school bus without insurance, and it also provides penalties for owners of school buses for allowing them to be operated without insurance.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a school bus driver knowingly operating a school bus without the required insurance shall be fined not more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if the owner of a school bus knowingly allows the school bus to be operated without the security required by <u>proposed law</u> he shall be fined not more than \$1,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a school bus operating without the security required by <u>proposed law</u> is involved in an accident, the owner shall be fined not more than \$1,000, the vehicle's registration will be revoked for 60 days, and the school bus driver's commercial driver's license shall be suspended for 1 year, if he had knowledge that the bus was uninsured.
