Wesley Bishop HB No. 1001

Abstract: Authorizes the city of New Orleans to sell abandoned or blighted property in the Lower Ninth Ward for \$100 per parcel.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the city of New Orleans to sell abandoned parcels that is situated in the Lower Ninth Ward, to private owners or entities for \$100 per parcel. Defines abandoned parcels as means an immovable property that has been adjudicated to a political subdivision for nonpayment of taxes or which has been acquired by a political subdivision for nonpayment of taxes or by other means which property is vacant or not lawfully occupied and which can be used presently for housing or can be revitalized for housing.

Proposed law is only effective upon the passage and enactment of H.B. No. 489 of the 2014 R.S.
