DIGEST

Heitmeier (SB 505)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides any board issued license or permit to a physician shall be automatically suspended upon a physician's conviction or entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a felony that constitutes a crime of violence as defined in <u>present law</u>, arises out of the practice of medicine, or arises out of the billing for health care services.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the automatic suspension shall remain in effect from the date of conviction or plea until the conclusion of the administrative proceedings and issuance of a final decision, consent order or other order by the board pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides an individual whose license has been automatically suspended may request an expedited hearing before the board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
