Provides relative to alternative nicotine products

<u>Present law</u> provides for the unlawful possession, sales, purchase, and distribution of tobacco products to minors. <u>Proposed</u> <u>law</u> adds alternative nicotine products to the present law prohibitions. <u>Present law</u> provides in order to prevent persons under the age of 18 years of age from purchasing or receiving tobacco products from vending machines or self-service displays, the sale or delivery of tobacco products through a vending machined or self-service display is prohibited. <u>Proposed</u> <u>law</u> adds alternative nicotine products to the present law prohibitions. Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.


