## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

## There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

Per an official with the Secretary of State's office, although the bill states that an election shall be held for the purpose of the measure, it is unlikely that a special election would be scheduled solely for the purpose of this measure. The item would most likely be included in a general election ballot at no additional cost.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Beginning in fiscal year 2016, this measure may decrease local fund revenue by an undetermined amount.

Per this measure, municipalities and parishes may continue to collect traffic fines based on evidence captured by automated traffic enforcement systems until 7/1/2015, after which a vote will determine if the fines will continue to be collected.

The Baton Rouge City-Parish Finance Department estimates that if voters do not approve the use of automated traffic enforcement systems, the reduction in fines may result in a loss of \$7,056,000 over the next five years.

The Lafayette Consolidated Government Finance Department estimates that if voters do not approve the use of automated traffic enforcement systems, the reduction in fines may result in a loss of \$8,075,000 over the next five years.
