HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 12

CONDOLENCES: Recognizes the life and legacy of Trevor Sims and expresses condolences upon his death

A RESOLUTION

2	To honor the life, impact, and legacy of Trevor Sims, the eleven-year-old young man who
3	helped raise thousands of dollars and donations for the Greater Baton Rouge Food
4	Bank while fighting his own battle with cancer and to express condolences upon his
5	passing; and
6	WHEREAS, Trevor Sims was diagnosed with cancer at the age of five; after eleven
7	months of chemotherapy and six months of radiation, his cancer was in remission, but it later
8	reappeared; and
9	WHEREAS, Trevor again achieved remission but when the cancer appeared a third
10	time, he was diagnosed as terminal and passed away on the morning of Wednesday, October
11	16, 2013; and
12	WHEREAS, upon his terminal diagnosis, he was asked about things he wanted to do
13	before he died, and his response was that he wanted to feed the hungry; and
14	WHEREAS, during his illness and battle with cancer, Trevor's loving and devoted
15	mother, Allison, had to stop working to take care of him, so Trevor knew first hand what it
16	felt like to not be able to afford food; and
17	WHEREAS, in September 2013, Trevor spearheaded a citywide food drive that
18	helped to fill the shelves of the local food bank; the event raised 34,798 pounds of food and
19	\$48,391 in monetary donations; and
20	WHEREAS, the "Trevor's Wish" campaign, a collaboration between Trevor and his
21	friends, Healing Place Church, and the Greater Baton Rouge Food Bank, produced donations

1 from out-of-state by sharing Trevor's story on social media; Select Media, a Pennsylvania 2 chain of specialty hospitals and rehabilitation facilities, had sixteen events that raised 3 donations for local food banks in twelve states; and 4 WHEREAS, the Central Community School System also raised \$16,000 in donations for Trevor's cause; in total, the "Trevor's Wish" campaign was able to raise the equivalent 5 6 of 350,953 meals; and 7 WHEREAS, Trevor was featured on multiple local television programs for his efforts 8 to help those in need, particularly those who hunger, all the while in the midst of his own 9 struggle with a terminal diagnosis; and 10 WHEREAS, on Wednesday, November 13, 2013, the Baton Rouge Metro Council 11 voted to rename the North Boulevard Bridge the Trevor Sims Memorial Bridge in honor of 12 Trevor; the bridge overlooks the St. Vincent de Paul dining facility for the homeless; and 13 WHEREAS, Trevor's death has brought unimaginable pain to his friends and loved 14 ones, who have found solace in their faith and religion; and 15 WHEREAS, Trevor was one of a kind; a young man of grace, spirituality, poise, and 16 compassion who will be remembered as a champion and advocate of the impoverished in his 17 community; and 18 WHEREAS, if life were measured by the number of other lives a person touches and 19 not by the number of years he is alive, Trevor's number would be in the tens of thousands; 20 he leaves a legacy that transcends his time and place in history and that will guide and 21 inspire generations to come; and 22 WHEREAS, the death of Trevor Sims has left an unspeakable emptiness in the hearts 23 of his family members and friends, who have found comfort in the knowledge that he lived 24 his life heroically and that his legacy will forever be an inspiration to others; and 25 WHEREAS, Trevor continues to be mourned and sorely missed by those who had 26 the honor of knowing him and who will always remember him as a selfless, courageous, 27 young man and whose legacy will help feed the hungry in the Baton Rouge community for 28 years to come; and

1 WHEREAS, Trevor's life was a gift to the state of Louisiana, and his profound 2 passion and purpose in life defined a movement to help give to those in need and continues 3 to bring honor to himself, his legacy, his family, his friends, his state, and this nation. 4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 5 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby extend deepest sympathies to the members of the 6 family of Trevor Sims and his fellow citizens; does hereby honor the lasting impact that his 7 life has had in the Baton Rouge community; does hereby extend appreciation and admiration 8 for his efforts to eradicate hunger among our most vulnerable citizens; does hereby record 9 for posterity the tremendous accomplishments that Trevor's mission has made over the past 10 year; does hereby acknowledge with immense gratitude the heroic deeds of this brave 11 gentleman who was selfless through his final moments; does hereby express the deep regret 12 of the entire state upon the loss of this extraordinary young man; and does hereby recognize
