11	<u>A.</u> None of the provisions of this Part shall apply to:
12	(1) Any commissioned physician or surgeon of the United States Army,
13	Navy, or Public Health Service, practicing in the discharge of his official duties;
14	(2) The administration of first aid in cases of emergency;
15	(3) Practitioners of allied health fields, duly licensed, certified, or registered
16	under other laws of this state;
17	(4) Anyone attending a woman in childbirth in an emergency;
18	(5) The practice of Christian Science or religious rules or ceremonies as a
19	form of religious worship, devotion or healing, if the persons administering, making
20	use of, assisting, or prescribing this practice rely on faith and prayer alone, do not
21	prescribe or administer drugs, or medicine, or perform surgical or physical
22	operations, or assume the title of, or hold themselves out to be, physicians or
23	surgeons.
24	B. No requirement for licensure established by this Part shall apply to an
25	individual licensed to practice medicine in another state or country when he
26	accompanies and attends to athletes and staff of an athletic team or organization
27	domiciled in another state or country during or in connection with an athletic contest
28	or event conducted in Louisiana, provided that the individual meets the conditions
29	for exemption provided in R.S. 37:1276.2."
