Claitor (SB 70)

<u>Present law</u>, the Balanced Treatment for Creation-Science and Evolution-Science Act, was held unconstitutional by the United States Supreme Court in *Edwards v. Aguillard*, *LA* (1987), 107 S.Ct. 2573, 482 U.S. 578, 96 L.Ed. 2d 510.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective August 1, 2014.
