Walsworth (SB 369)

<u>Present law</u> sets a 50 fish possession limit for crappie on state waters and also provides a 100 fish possession limit for crappie on Lake D'Arbonne.

Proposed law changes the limit from 100 to 50 on Lake D'Arbonne.

Effective August 1, 2014.
