5	Section 1. R.S. 13:5401(C)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§5401. District courts; reentry courts; subject matter

8	C. The following district courts may assign certain divisions of the court as
9	a reentry division of court in accordance with the provisions of this Section:

11	(5) The Fifteenth Judicial District Court.

Abstract: Authorizes the 15th JDC to create a reentry division of court.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the 11th JDC, the 19th JDC, the 22nd JDC, and the Criminal District Court for the parish of Orleans to create a reentry division which would be responsible for developing a workforce development sentencing program with specific qualifications and requirements.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the 15th JDC to establish a reentry division of court.
