## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The fiscal impact of the proposed legislation is indeterminable. This bill requires that no fewer than 5% of the total purchased chairs shall have arms following the renovation or construction of a state building. To the extent a renovation/new construction project did not initially include purchasing chairs with arms, this legislation may result in an increase of approximately \$50 to \$100 per chair or may result in fewer overall chairs being purchased to stay within the anticipated budget. Most building plans include the purchase of various chairs (with or without arms). Thus, the requirements of this legislation may already in place.

This bill only applies to public seating areas of state buildings. Typically, chairs with arms costs approximately \$50 to \$100 more than chairs without arms.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
