- 4 On page 1, line 3, after "proceedings;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 4 5 through 8 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 6 "to provide for declaratory judgments; to provide for expedited hearings; to provide 7 for the effect of supplemental proceedings on the hearing for a declaratory judgment; 8 to provide for proceedings for temporary restraining orders, injunctions, and 9 mandamus relative to the expenditure of state funds; and to provide for related 10 matters."
- 11 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 12 On page 1, line 10, change "3601(A)" to "1878"
- 13 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 14 On page delete lines 12 through 20 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 15 "Art. 1878. Supplemental relief: expedited hearing for constitutional determination; 16 effect of pendency of other proceedings
- 17 <u>A.</u> Further relief based on a declaratory judgment or decree may be granted 18 whenever necessary or proper. The application therefor shall be by petition to a 19 court having jurisdiction to grant the relief. If the application is considered 20 sufficient, the court, on reasonable notice, shall require any adverse party whose 21 rights have been adjudicated by the declaratory judgment or decree, to show cause 22 why further relief should not be granted forthwith.
- B. In any action or proceeding seeking a declaratory judgment as to the constitutionality of the expenditure of state funds, the court shall set the matter with preference and proceed to hear and determine the matter as expeditiously as the ends of justice may require, notwithstanding resolution of a pending petition for injunction sought pursuant to Article 3601 or a petition for mandamus sought pursuant to Article 3862."
