## DIGEST

Mills (SB 564)

<u>Present law</u> provides for a deputy chief of police to have not less than eight years of full-time law enforcement experience and shall at least hold the rank of sergeant in the classified police service at the time of his appointment.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the qualifications for the position of deputy chief of police in the city of St. Martinville. Further provides that the candidate must have five years of full-time law enforcement experience.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
