## DIGEST

Claitor (SB 566)

<u>Present law</u> provides for a board member to serve his term until a successor is appointed and qualified.

<u>Present law</u> provides that member may be removed only for cause determined by the governing authority of the appointing parish. Further provides that the board shall declare a member's office vacant upon the member's conviction of a felony and a plea for nolo contendere to a felony offense. Finally, provides that a member shall be deemed to have abandoned his office upon failure to attend two of any three consecutive regularly scheduled meetings without an excuse approved by a resolution of the board at the next regular meeting, and that a vacancy shall be deemed to exist in that member's office beginning at such time.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the removal of a board member immediately if removed for cause, at which time the governing body of the appointing parish is to appoint a temporary replacement to the board immediately or within 14 days.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the temporary appointee is to remain on the board until a successor is appointed and qualified and is not eligible for reappointment for a term.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
