TRANSPORTATION: Provides for fixed guideway rail systems

2	To enact R.S. 48:214, relative to public transportation safety; to provide for fixed guideway
3	rail systems; to designate the office of multimodal planning as the state safety
4	oversight entity; to provide for duties and powers of the office; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 48:214 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§214. Fixed guideway rail systems; safety
9	A. The office of multimodal planning of the Department of Transportation
10	and Development is hereby designated as the state safety oversight entity pursuant
11	to 49 U.S.C. 5329(e)(4).
12	B. As the state safety oversight entity, the office shall have the following
13	powers and duties only to the extent necessary to fulfill its obligations under federal
14	<u>law:</u>
15	(1) Enter onto and inspect the property of operators of fixed guideway rail
16	systems receiving federal funds without prior notice to such operators.
17	(2) Audit operators of fixed guideway rail systems receiving federal funds
18	for compliance with federal and state laws regarding the safety of fixed guideway

2	by a specific operator pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 5329(d).
3	(3) Direct the operator of a fixed guideway rail system to correct a safety
4	hazard by a specified date and time.
5	(4) Take legal action in a court of competent jurisdiction to compel an
6	operator of a fixed guideway rail system to correct a safety hazard, or to prevent the
7	operation of all or part of a fixed guideway rail system that the office has determined
8	to be unsafe.
9	(5) Audit, review, approve, and oversee operators of fixed guideway rail
10	systems receiving federal funds for compliance with a plan adopted by a specific
11	operator in compliance with Title 49, Section 5329(d) of the United States Code.
12	(6) Enforce statutes, regulations, executive orders, and rules relating to the
13	operation of a fixed guideway rail public transportation system in Louisiana.
14	(7) Implement such rules and regulations as may be necessary in order to
15	comply with this Section, and as may be promulgated by the Louisiana Department
16	of Transportation and Development, in accordance with the Louisiana
17	Administrative Procedure Act.

Leger HB No. 446

Abstract: Designates the office of multimodal planning as the state safety oversight entity for fixed guideway rail systems and gives them the authority to inspect, audit, review, enforce laws, implement rules and regulations, and take action against unsafe operators and systems.

Proposed law designates the office of multimodal planning in the Dept. of Transportation and Development as the state safety oversight entity for fixed guideway rail systems pursuant to federal law.

Proposed law grants the office the authority to inspect, audit, review, enforce laws, implement rules and regulations, and take action against operators and fixed guideway rail systems.

(Adds R.S. 48:214)
