13	services provided to the gestational mother prior to the birth and up to six
14	months after birth.
15	(c) Payment of actual lost wages of the gestational mother, not
16	covered under a disability insurance policy, when bed rest has been
17	prescribed for the gestational mother for some maternal or fetal complication
18	of pregnancy and the gestational mother, who is employed, is unable to work
19	during the prescribed period of bed rest.
20	(d) Payment of actual travel costs related to the pregnancy and

33	§94. Forms for collection of data
34	The state registrar shall prescribe forms for the collection of
35	information and statistics with respect to enforceable gestational surrogacy
36	contracts. Such forms shall require, but not be limited to, the following
37	information:
38	(1) The age, marital status, and state and parish of domicile of the
39	gestational mother.
	
40	(2) The parish in which the in utero embryo transfer took place.

6	§95. Completion of forms; filing with vital records registry
7	The physician performing the in utero embryo transfer or termination
8	of the pregnancy by birth, miscarriage, or abortion shall provide the
9	information required by the provisions of R.S. 40:94. Such completed forms
10	shall be transmitted by the physician or physicians to the vital records
11	registry within fifteen days of the performance of the medical procedures.
12	§96. Failure to complete form; penalty
13	The Department of Health and Hospitals shall promulgate by rule the
14	penalty for the failure to complete the forms as provided in R.S. 40:95.
15	§97. Confidentiality
16	The vital statistics records required by this Part and the identities of
17	the parties to a gestational surrogacy contract shall be confidential and shall
18	not be subject to disclosure, release, or inspection except upon application to
19	a competent court and in conformity with the applicable requirements of
20	confidentiality applicable to adoptions in the Children's Code. The reporting
21	of the data for public health purposes shall redact any identifying information
22	and any public report shall indicate patient numbers as assigned pursuant to
23	rules promulgated by the Department of Health and Hospitals.
