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Provides for the regulation of explosives. (8/1/14)

<u>Present law</u> provides for the regulation of explosives by the Department of Public Safety. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the deputy secretary or his designee to inspect all facilities for the manufacture, transportation, storage, and use of explosives by any person licensed for various explosive licenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that each manfucaturer, dealer-distributor, and user shall possess a valid explosives license or permit from the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.
