1 2 To enact R.S. 33:2476(B)(1)(d) and (C)(4), relative to the city of New Iberia municipal fire and police civil service system board; to provide for membership on the board; to 3 provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 33:2476(B)(1)(d) and (C)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §2476. Municipal fire and police civil service boards 9 10 B.(1)(a)11 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (b) of this 12 Paragraph, only one member shall be elected from the city of New Iberia 13 municipal fire and police civil service system in accordance with Paragraph (C)(4) of this Section, provided that such exception is approved by resolution of 14 the city of New Iberia governing authority. 15 16 C. 17

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (3) of this Paragraph, in the event R.S. 33:2495.2 becomes applicable, only one member shall be elected from the city of New Iberia municipal fire and police civil service system and one member shall be appointed by the mayor of the city of New Iberia upon his own nomination, provided that such exception is approved by resolution of the city of New Iberia governing authority.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for two members of a municipal fire and police civil service system to be elected from the municipal fire and the municipal police departments.

Proposed law provides for only one member to be elected from the city of New Iberia municipal fire and police civil service system, provided that such exception is approved by resolution of the city of New Iberia governing authority. Proposed law further provides for the mayor of the city of New Iberia to appoint one member to the board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
