DIGEST

Gary Smith (SB 418)

<u>Present law</u> requires the registration of every vehicle. Requires an individual applying for initial registration of a vehicle to provide or include a copy of a current and valid photo identification.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows an individual who does not possess any of the required credentials to certify, on a form approved by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, that he does not possess any of the credentials specified.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the execution of a false, fraudulent, or altered certification may be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.

Effective August 1, 2014.

(Amends R.S. 47:501(C)(1) and (2); adds R.S. 47:501(D))
