## **DIGEST**

Peterson (SB 587)

<u>Present law</u> provides for the district to be governed by a five-member board of commissioners.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides for an increase on the board of commissioners <u>from</u> five <u>to</u> seven members.

<u>Present law</u> provides for one member to serve an initial term of one year, two members shall serve initial terms of two years; and two members shall serve an initial term of three years, as determined by lot at the first meeting of the board held after the members are appointed.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides for a flat fee not to exceed \$150 per year for improved residential parcels subject to a special assessment, and \$100 for unimproved residential or commercial parcels. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for a flat fee per commercial parcels to not exceed \$375 for each municipal address assigned to an improved commercial parcel.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires an election to be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled municipal, state, or federal election when the parcel fee is to be renewed.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
