HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT. Requests the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners to require an annual one hour of continuing education on end of life care for all disciplines licensed by the board.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners to require an annual
3	one hour of continuing education on end of life care for all disciplines licensed by
4	the board.
5	WHEREAS, in 2012 an estimated one million five hundred thousand to one million
6	six hundred thousand patients received services from hospice; and
7	WHEREAS, over the past decade, the hospice industry has been marked by
8	substantial growth in the number of hospice programs and patients served; and
9	WHEREAS, as the average life span in the United States has increased so has the
10	number of individuals who die of chronic progressive diseases that require longer term and
11	more sustained care; and
12	WHEREAS, according to 2012 Medicare information, nearly half of all dying
13	Louisianians received hospice care.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
15	urge and request the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners to require an annual one
16	hour of continuing education on end of life care for all disciplines licensed by the board
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
18	executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners.
