 - (iv) More than one conviction for any type of motor vehicle for serious traffic violations contained in Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Regulations.
 - (v) Any conviction for a violation of military, state, or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than a parking violation, arising in connection with any traffic accident, and has no record of an accident in which he or she was at fault.
 - (b) Provides evidence and certifies that he:
 - (i) Is or was regularly employed within the last ninety days in a military position requiring operation of a CMV.
 - (ii) Was exempted from the CDL requirements in Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Regulations.
- 25 (iii) Was operating a vehicle representative of the CMV the driver applicant operates or expects to operate, for at least the two years immediately preceding 26 27 discharge from the military."
