Norton HB No. 1189

Abstract: Creates the crime of unlawful exposure of unsafe firearms to children and provides criminal penalties.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the crime of unlawful exposure of unsafe firearms to children.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines the crime as the intentional or criminally negligent exposure by anyone who is 17 years of age or older to any child under the age of 10 years to a firearm which is not secured in a locked container or equipped with a tamper-resistant trigger lock, cable lock, mechanical lock, or other safety device that is properly engaged so as to render the firearm inoperable.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides penalties for a first violation of a fine of not more than \$300. Provides penalties for a second or subsequent violation of a fine of not more than \$500, imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
