HOUSE BILL NO. 1233

BY REPRESENTATIVE SEABAUGH

TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS: Prohibits municipalities from issuing citations on an interstate unless at least one linear mile in each direction of the interstate is included within the city limits

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:398.1(D), relative to issuance of traffic citations; to prohibit municipalities
3 from issuing traffic citations on an interstate under certain circumstances; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 32:398.1(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §398.1. Traffic citations; form; issuance

8 * * *

9 D. Law enforcement agencies of a municipality are prohibited from issuing
10 traffic citations to a person driving on an interstate unless at least one linear mile in
11 each direction of the interstate is within the city limits of the municipality.

Abstract: Prohibits law enforcement agencies of a municipality from issuing traffic citations on an interstate unless at least one linear mile in each direction of the interstate is within the city limits.

Proposed law prohibits law enforcement agencies of a municipality from issuing traffic citations to drivers operating on the interstate unless at least one linear mile in each direction of the interstate is within the city limits of the municipality.
