PUBLIC CONTRACTS EG SEE FISC NOTE GF EX See Note
Provides relative to certain governmental agreements with private parties. (gov sig)

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Proposed law provides that for any governmental agreements with private parties that are not subject to review by the office of contractual review and under which the total value is greater than \$50,000, certain specific provisions shall be required in the agreement or shall be prohibited from inclusion in the agreement. If these conditions are not met, the agreement is inequitable and contrary to the public policy of the state. Proposed law provides the legislature declares null, void, unenforceable and against public policy any agreement referenced. Proposed law provides that the attorney general and district attorney may enforce the provisions of this Act. Effective upon governor's signature. Proposed law provides that nothing shall apply to contracts, permits or servitudes with member owned electric cooperatives or investor owned utilities regulated by the LA Public Service Commission or the City Council of New Orleans.
