EDUCATION DEPARTMENT. Requires DOE to report annually specified information regarding the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program to state legislators. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:4024, relative to the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program; to provide relative to program reporting requirements; to 3 require the Department of Education to report annually certain information regarding 4 5 the program to state legislators and certain legislative committees; and to provide for 6 related matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. R.S. 17:4024 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §4024. Reports 9 10 A. The department annually shall report to the Senate Committee on 11 Education, the House Committee on Education, and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, and each individual legislator regarding the implementation of the 12 13 program, including the number of eligible students receiving scholarships, a list of participating schools and the number of scholarship recipients each such school 14 15 enrolled, and aggregate test result data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in each participating school. The report, at a minimum, shall include the following 16 information: 17

	(1) The total number of students receiving scholarships.
	(2) A list of all schools participating in the program.
	(3) A list of all schools participating in the program grouped by
	legislative district.
	(4) The total student enrollment of each participating school, the
	number of scholarship recipients enrolled in each school, and the percentage of
	the total enrollment of each school represented by scholarship recipients.
	(5) Aggregate test result data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in
	each participating school.
	B. Not later than April thirtieth of each year, the department shall send
	a printed copy of the report required by this Section to each legislative
	committee as provided in Subsection A of this Section and to each member of
	the legislature.
	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
;	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
1	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
,	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
(	effective on the day following such approval.

## **DIGEST**

Brown (SB 31)

<u>Present law</u> requires the Department of Education (DOE) to report annually to the Senate Committee on Education, the House Committee on Education, and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget regarding the implementation of the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program, including the number of eligible students receiving scholarships, a list of participating schools and the number of scholarship recipients each such school enrolled, and aggregate test result data for the scholarship recipients enrolled in each participating school.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds each individual legislator to the list of entities that DOE must report to annually.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally requires that the report include a list of all participating schools grouped by legislative district and the percentage of the total enrollment of each school represented by scholarship recipients.

Coding: Words which are struck through are deletions from existing law; words in **boldface type and underscored** are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the DOE to send a printed copy of the report to each member of the legislature and to certain legislative committees not later than April 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

## <u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill</u>

- 1. Deletes requirement for preparation of a separate report for legislators and instead requires that the Dept. of Education report contain a list of participating schools grouped by legislative district.
- 2. Requires the Dept. of Education to send a printed copy of the report to each legislator not later than April 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.

## Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

- 1. Adds individual legislators to list of entities that DOE must report to.
- 2. Adds information that must be included in the annual report.
- 3. Requires that a printed copy of the report shall be sent to certain legislative committees.
