Proposed law provides that no agency, officer, or employee of Louisiana, acting on behalf of the state, shall engage in an activity that aids in the implementation or enforcement of the provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) of 2010 and any subsequent federal act that amends PPACA. Provisions of this measure terminate on December 31, 2016.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This measure provides for a 3 year moratorium on the implementation of all provisions of the Affordable Care Act. This measure would prevent the state from participating in provisions of the ACA, which include the expansion of Medicaid for individuals to 138% of the federal poverty level, and would prevent the state or any entity within the state from providing assistance with the implementation of Health Insurance Exchanges. Information provided by the Department of Health and Hospitals indicates this measure would further prevent certain provisions of ACA already implemented within the Medicaid program. Such provisions include the extension of Medicaid coverage to former foster care children up to the age of 26, and required changes in the eligibility determination methodology (utilization of the Modified Adjusted Gross Income to calculate eligibility). The impact to DHH as a result of this measure is indeterminable. To the extent DHH is considered out of compliance with required federal regulations as a result of this measure, it is unknown if Louisiana would be at risk for a disallowance and federal fund match sanctions from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
