WEAPONS/FIREARMS

OR NO IMPACT See Note

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Authorizes the possession of short barrel firearms without federal registration for lifetime concealed handgun permit holders

<u>Present federal law</u> requires that a person register certain firearms in accordance with Title 18 or Title 26 of the United States Code as applicable.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the holder of a lifetime concealed handgun permit may possess certain firearms without complying with the provisions of Titles 18 or 26 of the United States Code.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "firearm" as including a shotgun having a barrel of less than eighteen inches in length, a rifle having a barrel of less than sixteen inches in length, or any weapon made from either a rifle or a shotgun if the weapon has been modified to have an overall length of less than twenty-six inches.
