LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates the American Paint Horse as the state horse.

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:161.2, relative to state symbols; to provide for the official state horse; and  
3 to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:161.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§161.2. State horse**

7 **There shall be an official state horse. The official state horse shall be the**  
8 **American Paint Horse. Its use on official documents of the state and with the**  
9 **insignia of the state is hereby authorized.**
