St. Germain HB No. 285

Abstract: Specifies the length of time documentation of school attendance is valid for purposes of a minor's driving privileges.

<u>Present law</u> provides no minor may be issued a driver's license or learner's permit for the operation of a motor vehicle unless, at the time of application, documentation is presented to the department that the minor is enrolled and is attending a school as defined herein.

<u>Present law</u> provides upon request of any minor who is enrolled and attending school and who is eligible to apply for a license, the appropriate authority shall provide to him a documentation form developed by the Dept. of Education and made available to all school boards, home school providers, and adult education supervisors, of his compliance.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides documentation of school attendance provided to the minor by the appropriate authority is valid for a period of 90 days from the date of issuance.
